Today, December 20th, 2022, Thai and Japanese students and teachers arrived at Princess Chulabhorn Science High School Chiang Rai. They then participated in a local wisdom event. These activities were held to impart knowledge and introduce Thai Lanna culture to students and teachers. Activities were divided into four stations. Your first stop is Bai Si Su Kwan or the calling of the soul ceremony. This is a ceremony to welcome guests from Japan and Thailand to participate in this event. Second stop is Tung Sai Moo and Tung Tewada, Lanna flags.

Grade 11 students from Princess Chulabhorn Science High School Chiang Rai demonstrated how to make beautiful Lanna flags and the participants joined in. Our next stop was local snacks and herbal drinks. The snacks were Khao Thom Hua Ngok, boiled sticky rice wrapped in banana leaves and Khao Phuk Nga, sticky rice mixed with black sesame. Herbal drinks were Ampanpilai or yellow drink, Kommenchuanchnen or deep red juice, and Unchanpirom or butterfly pea flower juice. Finally, our last stop was traditional music. It is a traditional stringed instrument ensemble, Salaw, Saw, Seung and northern style traditional music performed in song.
